What are your state reporting requirements for DUI arrest and conviction?

Washington State's definition of unprofessional conduct "(17) Conviction of any gross misdemeanor or felony relating to the practice of the person's profession. For the purposes of this subsection, conviction includes all instances in which a plea of guilty or nolo contendere is the basis for conviction and all proceedings in which the sentence has been deferred or suspended. Nothing in this section abrogates rights guaranteed under chapter 9.96A RCW".

Application explanation from one of our attorney's "The words "relating to the practice of the person's profession" are not clearly defined. However, several Washington court cases have interpreted the term (also used in the moral turpitude provision) to include things that "would lower the standing of the profession in the eyes of the public." That's not totally clear, but it is way broader than the statutory words might indicate. For example, a conviction for a felony or gross misdemeanor would almost always be related to the profession. "
